Further trial Information is as follows:

- Trials are open to all Wellington Athletes/Bowlers
- The top seven (7) in both men's and ladies will qualify
- The cost is \$30.00 per person per trial
- A Maximum of Four (4) trials only
- Trialist will bowl six (6) Games per trial
- To be eligible for team selection or the national DRAFT, trialist must bowl 24 Games (4 trials)
- To be eligible for team selection, trialist must trial at nominated centre only

ELGIBILITY

- Bowlers must have
 - i: bowl a minimum of 24 games in a recognised league during 2010 in the Region they wish to represent,
- Or
- ii: reside in the Region they wish to represent.
- Wellington North Region is Strike Porirua and Kapiti Bowl- (from Porirua, Kapiti up to and including Otaki)
- Wellington South Region is Strike Hutt and Bowlarama- (from Hutt, Wellington up to and including Tawa)
- All trialist will need to be WCBA members
- The trials will have a “**Closed Door**” format, which means you must be there Fifteen (15) minutes before the stated time or you will not be eligible for the “Lane Draw”
- The times stated in the table above are when bowling commences and there is a five (5) minute warmup beforehand.
- Bowling trials – A minimum of three [3] athletes per pair of lanes – up to five [5] per pair if required.
- Trials are expected to last approximately 2 ½ - 3 hours each
- there will be a lane condition between squads on the weekend trials
- Dress code to be neat and tidy – “No Jeans”

In each bowling centre on the noticeboard there will be an “Expression of Interest” form. Please fill in your Name under the trial dates you are interested in attending. This does not mean you are bound to attend this trial. This is to help book out the required lanes.
