Tournament Information and Playing Rules

Eligibility

The Wellington Graded Championship (WGC) is open to all current members of the Wellington Competitive Bowlers Association (WCBA). Proof of membership is required. If you are not a current member but would still like to compete in this tournament, you can join the WCBA prior to the cut off for entries (Tuesday 9th March 2010).

Rules

All standard Tenpin Bowling New Zealand playing and tournament rules will apply.

Format

Qualifying – 4 games (handicapped) of singles. Friday and Saturday squads available.
(Note: There will be a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 3 athletes per pair of lanes during qualifying)
Multiple entries will be allowed in this competition, with the best attempt counting towards the finals.

Finals – Sunday 9am. The top 16 athletes from the qualifying squads will bowl in the finals. Each finals 'tier' will be in a stepladder format.

The last match for 1st & 2nd place will be decided on the best out of 3 games. 3rd & 4th places will also play for titles and prizes (one game only). See finals diagram for more information.

No further payment is required if you qualify for the finals

Ties

In the event of a tie for the 16th place in qualifying, the highest last game will decide the finalist. If there is still a tie, a 9th&10th frame roll off will take place until a winner is found.

In the event of a tie in the finals, a 9th&10th frame roll off will be bowled until a winner is found.

Handicaps and Entering Averages

The handicapping will be based on 90% of 190.

Athletes entering this tournament must provide a current league average as at 1st October 2009.

Any athlete who cannot provide an average will bowl with a handicap of zero.

During the finals the handicaps will be reset and based on the athlete's qualifying scores.

Dress Code

A collared shirt must be worn, neat and tidy dress is required.

NO DENIM (i.e. jeans) are to be worn.

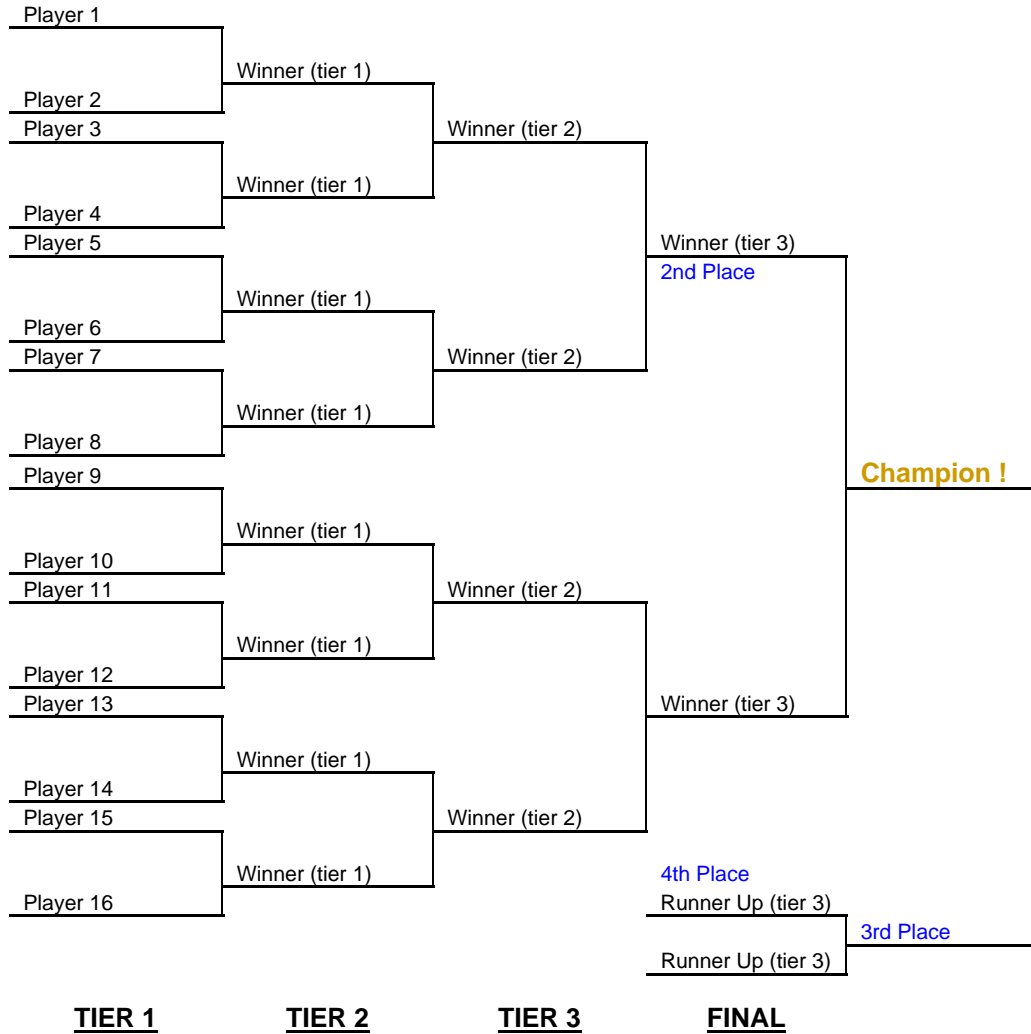
