

## N.Z.T.B.C. GOES INTO LIQUIDATION

On Friday 14th May NZTBC (New Zealand Tenpin Bowling Congress) was placed into liquidation at the request of the Department of Inland Revenue. This in turn means that New Zealand no longer has an official National Body for Tenpin Bowling and as a result means that all planned events including tournaments and the AGM due this month have been cancelled.

### How does this affect Tenpin Bowling for Wellington and the WCBA?

It doesn't really. We will carry on doing what we have been doing - acting in the best interests of tenpin bowling in Wellington. However it does significantly affect the national profile of the sport we love and makes it very difficult to seek assistance (financial or otherwise) from the national funding organizations such as SPARC, and Olympic / Commonwealth representation.

As you are aware, we held a vote last year as to whether we (the WCBA) should affiliate to NZTBC. The result of this vote was "No" and as such, the Association continues to work with whom ever it can to promote and grow the sport in Wellington. We continue to work towards recognition as a Regional Sporting Body and are making gradual progress in this area.

Plans are developing to ensure that the prestige national events and tournaments of the past continue. News on further developments should be available shortly. The WCBA will assist as required. We, the WCBA, believe that there must be some form of unified national body representing our sport, and as such, we will monitor and where appropriate support any developments that achieve this aim.

### Presidents Message

The recent demise of NZTBC is regrettable. A unified national body is essential for our sport and lets hope a replacement body emerges quickly. On a positive note, there has been some wonderful scoring of late, not to mention some meritorious tournament results both locally and nationally. Well done to all

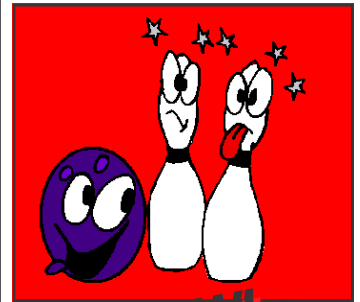
