## Coke High Roller

Over the weekend of November 24th—26th, some of the top bowlers in New Zealand gathered at Bowland Petone to contest the Coke High Roller Tournament.

With over \$11,000 in prizes up for grabs, interest was keen from not only the spectators hoping to see some impressive bowling, but also the other bowlers checking out the competition during qualifying.

Speaking to the Overall winner after the Best of the Best event in Porirua recently, he mentioned how after his 258 on the Friday night, he was so confident he'd make the finals & didn't even go to watch any of the squads bowl on the Saturday.

For those that don't know how this tournament works, the qualifying squads are made up of 10 games. The highest overall 11 individual games qualify for the finals along with the highest series from each squad.

Once in the finals, a further 10 games are played for increasing amounts of cash. If 2 players have scores within 10 pins, the top score takes 1/2 the cash for that game & the balance is added to the jackpot.

If a player wins a game by more than 10 pins over the next highest game, they take all the cash in the Jackpot in addition to 1/2 of the allocated cash for that game.

The 10th game is a winner takes all & the player with the most cash at the end, is crowned the Overall Champion.
